WHY GET A GCA MEMBERSHIP?



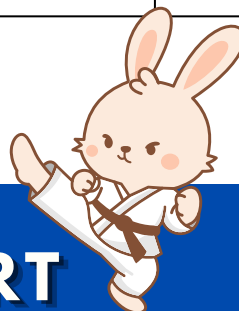

Message from the Greystone School Parent Council

SCC Building a Playful Community

In June 2026, the Greystone School Parent Council successfully installed two new outdoor structures for students and wider youth in the community to enjoy. Our fundraising and grant writing work in 2025-26 culminated in a new "Nine-Square-in-the-Air" court and a Gaga ball pit. The "Nine-Square" plays a little bit like a cross between Volleyball and King's Court. Gaga ball is also a newer activity and is a version of Dodge Ball (with the ball swatted along the ground).



Working closely with community members and Greystone School, we also initiated a longer-term project to beautify the front school yard with the addition of raised garden beds and fruit trees. Thank you to our volunteers, donors and sponsors who supported our 2025-26 projects.

RINK UPDATE

We are still a long way away from outdoor ice for this winter season. Around October our volunteer crew will assess the rink and take care of repairs, level the ground, and do anything needed so that we are ready to go when the temperatures dictate. Social Coordinator

- Brings ideas to the board for social events for the community
- Coordinates vendors for events, establishes lists of event supplies
- Submits grants for event funding

Soccer Coordinator

- Work closely with Saskatoon Youth Soccer to implement youth soccer teams in Greystone Heights
- Arrange team supports (coaches, managers, etc.) and equipment
- Represents the sport at all meetings of the association
- GCA has traditionally offered outdoor Spring Soccer – the active work for this position starts in Nov/Dec (planning phase) with most work being done through Jan-Mar

Basketball Coordinator

- Acts as liaison between GCA and the SMBA
- Is responsible for recruiting and appointing coaches
- Represents the sport at all meetings of the association
- Organizes schedules, equipment and teams for the sport

Rink Crew

- Clear/flood the rink as needed during the winter months
- Assist with rink maintenance

Newsletter Delivery

- Sign up for a newsletter route and help deliver our seasonal newsletters (1-2x per year)
- Several routes to be filled

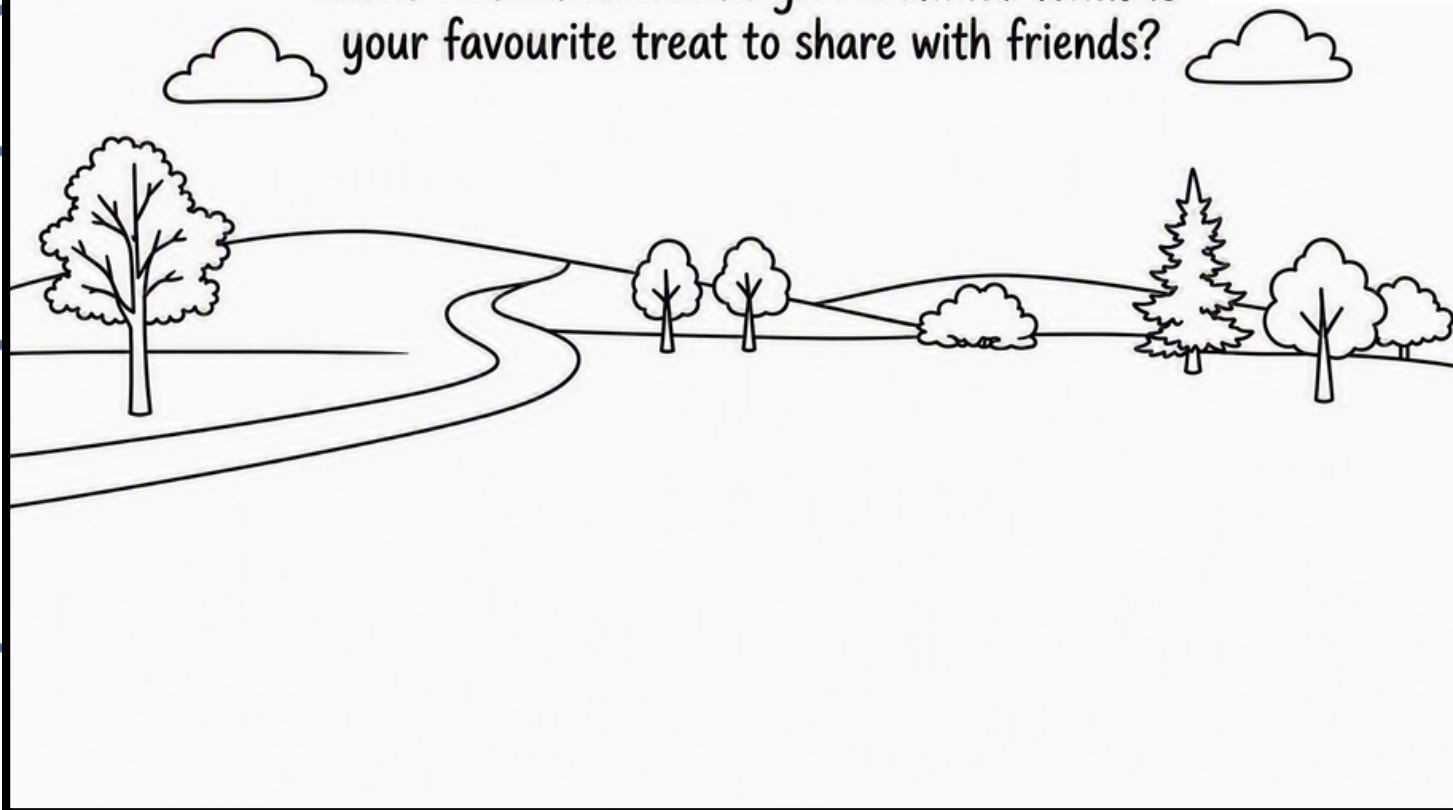
